10-13 weeks		<p><u>Non-Invasive First Trimester Testing:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Cell-Free DNA testing (as early As 10 weeks) ● Ultrascreen or Sequential Screen Part 1/Nuchal Translucency between 11 w 4 d -13 w 6 days <p><u>Invasive First Trimester Testing:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Chorionic Villous sampling (CVS) as early as 10 weeks) at Maternal Fetal Medicine.
16-23 weeks		<p><u>Non-Invasive Second Trimester Testing:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Alpha-Feto Protein (AFP) bloodwork @ HCFW of MFM (16-23 weeks) ● Sequential Screen -Part 2 blood work <p><u>Invasive Second Trimester Testing:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Amniocentesis (>16 weeks) @ MFM

26-28 weeks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 1 Hour Glucola test and Complete Blood Count (performed in our office, plan to be in our office for 1 hour) ● RhoGAM if indicated for patient (given at VHC Outpatient Lab) ● Fill out Pre-Registration form for hospital ● Appointments every 2 weeks 	
35+ weeks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Group B Streptococcus -Vaginal Culture (GBS) ● 36 Week Sonogram to check growth and position. ● Appointments weekly ● Weekly Cervical checks (as needed) 	
40 weeks	Due Date	
>40 weeks	Post-dates: Weekly Antenatal testing (non-stress test or BioPhysical Profile @ MFM or HCFW)
